Winter Storage: Winter produce items store very well if kept properly, and can last until early spring.

Carrots should be kept in bags to maintain high humidity, a 98% humidity for carrots is best. Ideally store carrots at 35°-40°F in a dark place.

Potatoes should be kept in a well ventilated container in a dark place. Ideally store potatoes at 45°-55°F.

Garlic keeps longest when stored at 60 to 65 degrees and in moderate humidity.

Onions should be kept between 32 to 40 F. An ideal location is dry and low in humidity to prevent rot and molds.
